Dear Residents:

Winter is knocking on our door once again and I would be remiss if I did not remind you that your tax bill should be arriving at your home no later than December 20th.

When you receive your 2023-2024 Tax Bill, it will arrive in a standard envelope and include (2) white return envelopes. This is a change from previous years, due to the increase in the cost of envelopes and to help reduce mail fraud.

These past few years, we have seen an increase in mail fraud. If you pay your own property taxes, not through your mortgage company, I highly suggest the use of our Online Payment Portal (Tax.IslipNY.gov) for the payment of your 2023-2024 property taxes. Using this portal will eliminate the chances of becoming a victim of mail fraud. You will also receive email reminders of important due dates.

However, if you choose to pay in person, our office will process payments starting in early-mid December, Monday - Friday from 8:30 am - 4:15 pm. For your convenience, we will be open late on Wednesday, January 10, 2024 until 7:00 pm, as this is the last day to pay your first half taxes without penalty.

PROGRAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION

STEP ONE:

Obtain a Recreation Card: A Town of Islip Recreation Card is needed to register for most programs and to access mainland beach parking and many other town facilities. Please complete the Recreation/Senior Card Application and return it to Brookwood Hall via mail, email or in person. The application can be found on pages 7-8 or on our website (islipny.gov). Your card will be mailed to you. For more information, please call or email us at (631) 224-5431 or IDRoom@islipny.gov.

Anyone 12 or older must obtain a Recreation Card. **A Recreation Card costs \$30 and is good for two years.** Replacement cards cost \$15 and will have the original card's expiration date.

- Family rates: First member pays full price and each additional family member pays half price – only available when purchased at the same time.
- Senior citizens 60 years or older may obtain a **FREE** Senior Citizen Card by using the application on pages 7-8. For more information, call (631) 224-5431.
- Non-resident cards are available for use at Ronkonkoma Beach. The cost is \$50 and is valid for two years and can be purchased at Brookwood Hall or Ronkonkoma Recreation Center.
- To obtain a Recreation Card, two current proofs of residency are required.
- **Adults:** Must provide a New York State driver's license (or a New York State non-driver ID card) PLUS one of the following – tax bill, utility bill, vehicle registration, car insurance bill, medical bill, credit card or bank statement or notarized rent receipt.
- **Children 12 to 18:** Parent's driver's license PLUS current school ID card PLUS either a recent report card or progress report.
- **For Pool Memberships Only - Children under 12:** Parent's driver's license PLUS child's birth certificate.
- For information on a Disabled Recreation Card, please call (631) 224-5431.

STEP TWO:

Follow the registration instructions for the program(s) of your choice. The Program/Camp Registration Form is on pages 5-6.

Our programs have different registration deadlines and procedures. All programs listed in this brochure are accompanied by a symbol that indicates the way you must register. You will encounter the following symbols:

 **Mail-In:** You must send your registration information and payment by mail during the time period specified. **NO DROP-OFFS ACCEPTED.** You must send a copy of your Recreation Card. If you are registering children for camp, include a copy of their birth certificate and immunization records. **Mail to:** Town of Islip, 50 Irish Lane, East Islip, NY 11730. Indicate the program choice on the front of the envelope.

 **Phone-In:** You must phone-in to register at a specific time. Be prepared to give credit card information or to make full payment within a week after registration.

 **In-Person:** You must register in person at the program site. Bring your Recreation Card and payment. In-person registrants usually begin on a specific date and are ongoing until enrollment limits are met.

 **Lottery Mail-In:** This type of registration is used for popular or limited enrollment programs in order to give every resident an equal opportunity to enroll. You must send a completed registration form, your payment (MasterCard, Visa or check payable to the Town of Islip) and a current copy of your child's immunization record. A doctor's note is required for medical conditions. **FIRST-TIME REGISTRANTS** must also send a copy of your child's birth certificate and a copy of your Recreation Card.

STEP THREE:

Register in a timely fashion. You must pay for programs at least 7 business days prior to the first class.

Refunds: No refunds are given unless you cancel 10 days prior to the first class. All refund requests will incur a processing fee per participant. Refund requests must be submitted in writing on an official Town of Islip Refund Form.

Payment: Checks (payable to Town of Islip), Visa and MasterCard are accepted. A 2.65% + \$.25 service fee will be applied to all credit card charges.






BOATER SAFETY CERTIFICATE REQUIREMENT COURSE

NYS requires all motorized vessel operators, regardless of age, to hold a boater safety certification by January 1, 2025.

All boaters born on or after January 1, 1978 are required to have certification by 2024.

*Personal Watercraft operators 14 years of age and older must have a Boater Safety Certificate.

After completion of this entire eight-hour class and passing the written test, the certificate obtained will last a lifetime and meets the NYS Safe Boater Certificate requirements. Please bring drinks, a bag lunch, pen and pencil.





Our mission statement is to serve as a resource to the Islip community by addressing accessibility, seeking equal rights, removing barriers and promoting opportunities for individuals with disabilities. The Board will attempt to define and implement goals for the improved quality of life for individuals with disabilities in the Town of Islip.

The 14-person Disability Advisory Board consists of volunteers, all of whom are Islip residents, and appointed by the Town Board. They represent and advocate for people with physical, developmental, and sensory disabilities.

The Town has a wide variety of programs and activities for all individuals and offers specific programs for those with disabilities, such as a free therapeutic modern dance program for developmentally disabled youth (funded by NYS OPWDD), and host a work-based learning program for area students. 




