Chapter 46. Solicitors and Canvassers

46-1.1 Prohibited acts.

- \_\_\_\_\_ A. It shall be unlawful for any person to enter upon residential premises, whether publicly or privately owned, for the purpose of soliciting or canvassing except after 9:00 a.m. of any day and prior to ½ before sunset. (Amended 7-17-18)
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ B. It shall be unlawful for any solicitor or canvasser, in plying his trade, to ring the bell or knock upon or enter any building whereon there is painted or otherwise affixed or displayed to the public view any sign containing any or all of the following words: "No Peddlers", "No Solicitors", "No Agents" or other wording the purpose of which purport to prohibit soliciting or canvassing on the premises.

It shall be unlawful for any person to solicit or canvass in, at or upon any residential property, whether such residential property is publicly owned or privately owned, except upon the prior invitation and with the prior consent of either an owner or a resident of such premises.
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ D. Term defined. For the purpose of this section, the term "resident" or "residential property", when applied to a hotel, motel, boatel, rooming house, boarding house or garden apartment, shall include an individual apartment, room or suite of rooms, building, structure or group of buildings or structures.
  
- \_\_\_\_\_ E. It shall be unlawful for any person to transfer or assign any license issued under the provisions of this chapter to any other person.
