

## Rules and Registration

- Entries to be set-up at St. John's Landmark Church on Sept 28 between 10 am 12 noon.
- > We reserve the right to disqualify entries that we determine to be distasteful, political, not family friendly or in disrepair.
- > Size can be between 4' and 6' and should fit in a 4x4 area. PVC pipe "holders" placed in the ground will be supplied to anchor your scarecrow. We recommend a 1x2 piece of lumber (or similar size alternative) for the center body so that it easily fits inside. You may add staking if necessary but must supply your own rope, zip ties, etc.
- Materials used should be durable and able to stand up to sun, wind and rain. All scarecrow decorations should be firmly attached, but you may bring hay bales, corn stalks, pumpkins, etc. . . to add to your display.
- > YOU ARE WELCOME TO VISIT YOUR SCARECROW TO KEEP IT IN GOOD CONDITION.
- > Prizes are as follows: First Place: \$100, Second Place: \$50, Third Place: \$25
- Voting will occur on Saturday, October 5 at Living History Cemetery Tour Event from 1 pm - 4 pm.
- Winners will be determined by the votes cast. Winner need not be present to win.
