Dear Atlantique Boater:

Enclosed you will find the 2017 Atlantique Marina Permit Application. In an effort to ensure that permits are issued correctly and efficiently, applications will be processed **BY MAIL ONLY**. You will not be able to obtain this permit in person. The fee for the permit is \$35; our Senior Citizen resident fee is \$20. Payment can be made by check, money order, Master Card or Visa. Please make check or money order payable to the Town of Islip. **Permits are non-transferable**. If you change your boat during the season simply return the original decal along with your new boat registration and a new decal will be issued at no additional charge.

Please return the completed application and submit with **four (4) proofs of residency**. We will accept a combination of the following for proof of residency:

- a copy of your boat registration or US Coast Guard Documentation **PLUS**
- a copy of your driver's license **PLUS**
- a copy of your property tax and utility bills (i.e., water, cable, electric, telephone, cell phone).

All proofs of residency and documentation must be in the same name and address. Utility bills must be recently dated. Photocopies are accepted. If you have any questions, please contact the Division of Marinas and Docks at (631) 224-5648. Failure to supply sufficient documentation will delay the approval of your application. Any outstanding dock fees owed from the past season must be paid before we will process your application. **Mail all documents and payment to: Brookwood Hall, Attn: Atlantique Permit, 50 Irish Lane, East Islip, NY 11730.**

The online reservation system will be active starting May 15 at 9am. B-slips (11' - 14') will be available for weekly reservations that run from Monday thru Sunday. Reservations must be booked at least 2 weeks prior to your scheduled reservation date. Weekly reservations will begin June 26. The last week for reservations will be August 28. Weekly slip rentals may be cancelled by providing written notice to the Town, which must be received at least one (1) week prior to the scheduled check-in date. A refund, less a \$10 processing fee, will be offered for cancellations made in accordance with this policy. Cancellations made less than one (1) week in advance of the scheduled check-in date will be charged in full. For more information or to reserve a slip please log onto www.islipny.gov.
