FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE  
SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT IN SUFFOLK  
COUNTY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 14 - PARKLAND

WHEREAS, a consortium of developers who are outside, but nearby, to the sewage treatment plant of Suffolk County Sewer District No. 14 - PARKLAND known as Parkland 14 Associates, have offered to enter upon the sewage treatment plant site and increase its capacity to service their developments at no cost to the present rate payers of the District, and

WHEREAS, it will be financially beneficial to County Sewer Districts to have the additional funds provided by sewer district contractees for their use of a county sewer district's sanitary sewage collection, treatment and disposal facilities; and

WHEREAS, it is in the environmental interest of all of Suffolk County to have as many entities as possible use communal sewage treatment and disposal facilities instead of on-site sewage disposal units;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the consortium be permitted to enter upon the plant site and make the necessary improvements at their own cost and expense, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the extra capacity of the completed plant shall be allotted approximately as follows:

Serota Park	210,000 gpd
Cartwright Industrial Park	80,000 gpd
Gateway Plaza	85,000 gpd
Holiday Park (Colony @ Holbrook)	108,000 gpd
Fox Ridge	153,000 gpd
Sherwood	7,000 gpd*

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Administrative Head of the District be and he hereby is authorized, directed, and empowered to enter into a contract with the developers for the developers to construct the necessary improvements upon such terms and conditions as the Administrative Head may deem necessary relating to the construction of the improvements to the sewage treatment plant of the Sewer District No. 14 - PARKLAND and that the developers be required to post letters of credit or cash or securities with the County Treasurer in those instances that the Administrative Head deems necessary to ensure performance of such agreements and contracts.
