## Suffolk County Environmental Center @ The Scully Estate

550 South Bay Avenue  
Islip NY 11751

1. LIE to Exit 56 or Sunrise Highway (Rte. 27) to Exit 45
2. Follow Route 111 south toward Islip
3. At end of 111 turn RIGHT onto Main St. (Rte. 27A)
4. Turn LEFT at first traffic light onto South Bay Ave.
5. Follow attendant instructions
